SPACES IN EARLY MORNING & AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

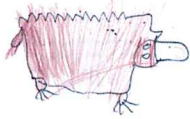

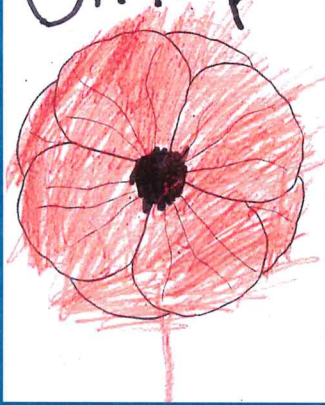
